

## **Admission Procedure – Class XI (FYJC)**

Admissions to Class XI are carried out strictly as per the rules and regulations of the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education (MSBSHSE) through the Centralised Online Admission Process (CAP).

### **Steps for Admission**

#### **1. Online Registration**

Students must register online through the official FYJC admission portal:

<https://mahafyjadmissions.in/>

#### **2. Fill Application Form**

Students should complete:

- Part 1 – Personal Information
- Part 2 – College & Stream Preferences  
carefully and accurately.

#### **3. Selection of Stream**

Students can apply for:

- Science
- Commerce
- Arts

#### **4. Merit-Based Admission**

Admissions are granted strictly on merit, reservation policies, and seat availability as prescribed by the Government of Maharashtra. Merit is generally prepared on the basis of SSC/Equivalent Examination marks.

#### **5. Merit List & Allotment**

The provisional and final merit lists are published online as per the admission schedule declared by the Education Department.

#### **6. Document Verification**

Students must submit original documents along with photocopies for verification:

- SSC Mark Sheet
- School Leaving Certificate
- Aadhaar Card
- Caste Certificate (if applicable)
- Non-Creamy Layer/EWS Certificate (if applicable)
- Passport Size Photographs

#### **7. Confirmation of Admission**

Admission will be confirmed only after:

- Verification of documents
- Payment of prescribed fees within the given time period.

#### **8. Eligibility for Other Boards**

Students from CBSE, ICSE, NIOS, or other boards must submit eligibility and migration documents as per Maharashtra Board norms.
